Biofuel revs up sales for outlet

RENEWABLE fuel is proving popular with motorists and sales almost doubling in the past six months at the Neumann Petroleum Eight Mile Plains site.

Neumann Petroleum general manager Charles Wright said sales of ethanol blended E-Gen have "grown significantly" since its in-

roduction in 2006.

"Our Eight Mile Plains site has been overwhelmed by demand for E-Gen," he said.

"In particular, E-Gen biodiesel - a blend of 20 per cent organic fuel and 80 per cent petroleum diesel - has been particularly popular as we are the only service

station on the south side that offers the biofuel."

Around 4500 vehicles pass through the site each week taking more than 80,000 litres of renewable fuel.
